Objective

- Incorporate to SMURF entities that might contribute to the SMURF project objectives providing knowledge, activities or solutions (collaboration).



Cascade funding

Open call of grants to third parties

to ensure the participation of the required stakeholders for the development of the overall project

(Wp2, Wp3, Wp4, Wp5, Wp6, Wp7)



Cascade funding characteristics

- •1,000,000€
- at least **40 organisations representing small scale forest owners across Europe** (like associations, confederations, cooperatives or others similar).
- **Selection criteria**: wide, varied and territorially distributed participation of the primary sector in the project.



Cascade funding characteristics

- Payment in 2 phases, 50% after selection and 50% at the end of the participation
- Personal costs of the organisation won't be financed. A
 detailed list will be provided with the call of grants (e.g. travel
 cost, contract professional services, set up or update
 existing digital equipment, others)




The main types of activities & financial support:

- (1) participating in **surveys, interviews** of WP2 (up to 3,000€),
- (2) effective participation in **interviews and working groups** in WP3 (up to 3,000€) & **implementation of new business models** in WP3 (up to 30,000€);
- (3) participate in **trainings and provide useful feedback** in WP4 (up to 3,000 €) & **participate in development of Close to Nature Sylviculture** (CNS) in WP4 (up to 10,000€);
- (4) effective participation in **implementation of new Payments for Ecosystem Services** (PES) and feedback in WP5 (up to 5,000€);
- (5) participation in **Clusters** in WP6 (up to 4,000€);
- (6) **joint communication and dissemination activities** of the projects, its new solutions and the results WP7 (up to 2,000€).
