

(CNS) forest management models

adapted to most common European bioregions
via modelling and field validation

O4. <u>Develop a unified European</u> Payment for Ecosystem Services (PES) system,

in terms of **carbon credit** validation requirement,
exchange platform and tokens,
to provide a common framework for small-forest owners
for afforestation and forest management practices implementation

O5. Co-create a comprehensive framework

by and for small-forest holders, policy-makers and other stakeholders

to support the transition towards

sustainable and profitable forest-based systems

O6. Maximise the impact of the project

through dissemination and communication of the project results to different audiences and through exploitation activities








